

# 'Living' Christmas Cards Fundraiser

Thank you for your involvement in this fundraiser. Your school/organisation appreciates your efforts in helping them raise money with this healthy, fun and educational product.



**Your organisation will raise 40% of each sale—that's \$2.00 per pack of cards!**

Please sell each of the 12 packs of cards in your carry bag for \$5 each. Collect the money in the money envelope and return to your school/organisation as soon as possible.

If your school/organisation is able to process credit cards, you may also like to use the credit card slip inside the envelope.

You may like to use the reverse side of this sheet to promote the fundraiser. Simply write the name of your school/organisation in the space provided and attach the sheet to the outside of your carry bag. You can also use it to help explain the product to people.



## Answers to some common questions

### What is seed-embedded paper?

Attached in each Christmas card, you will find a piece of paper in the shape of a Christmas tree. The paper is made from recycled paper that has had seeds added to it.

### How does the seeded paper work?

Soak the paper in water until soft. Place in a pot containing potting mix and lightly cover with more potting mix. Place the pot in a warm position and water regularly.

### What will grow from the seeded paper?

The seeds in the paper are native Australian Swan River Daisy (*Brachycome iberidifolia*).

The Swan River Daisy is an annual plant that can grow throughout most regions of Australia. It is a branching, low-lying plant that grows to around 30cm high and is spectacular in hanging baskets, pots or rockeries. It can tolerate a wide range of soils including sandy, saline or clay. Please protect from severe frosts or excessive humidity.

Swan River Daisy seeds germinate quickly (approximately 7 days) under warm conditions.

### Can the cards be sent overseas and throughout Australia?

The seeded paper is permitted in all Australian states and territories. We recommend investigating quarantine restrictions before sending overseas. Whilst you won't have any problems with them leaving Australia, different countries have their own import restrictions. If in doubt, you can easily detach the seeded paper before sending, plant the paper yourself and thank your overseas recipient for the flowers!

### Who designed the cards?

The artwork and messages on the cards are winning entries in an Australia-wide competition for children. Each child is credited with their artwork or message.
