

Veggie Growing Kits Fundraiser

Answers to some common questions

How long can I keep it before planting?

Your seeds can store for up to a year in a cool, dry place. Seed viability may diminish after this time.

When should I plant my seeds?

Each of the veggie varieties are recommended for planting in Spring. This may vary based on your location, eg: northern parts of Australia can grow virtually year-round. Gardening Australia have an excellent growing guide available at <http://abc.com.au/gardening/vegieguide/> where you can check what to plant when in your area.

How often and how much should I water?

The mini-greenhouses are designed to require very little water. Keep them in a warm (not hot) and sunny place and keep an eye on the soil surface. If it starts to look dry, dribble a small amount of water to moisten the soil. Aim to keep the greenhouses sealed and a decent level of condensation inside the lid. If you happen to overwater, the bottom tray can be separated from the inner seed-tray to empty excess water.

Can I re-use the greenhouse?

Absolutely. Once your veggie seedlings have grown and you have transplanted them, simply refill with soil and off you grow!
